<u>ACTION ITEM</u>: Committee/Office for Education can help course directors to make an informed decision on whether or not to require attendance, based on the educational activity.

- III. <u>Elective/Selective</u> Dr. DC Holmes & Ms. Michelle Krupp (see attachment)

  Please see the attached handout to reference the criteria for elective/selective courses that was discussed.
  - A. Main points of discussion included:
    - Issues in regards to overall cost and time for departments, students, and faculty were discussed.
    - Within the confines of the current curriculum structure, selectives may be a better option than electives (as defined on handout).
  - B. A few selective course options were discussed including:
    - D4 students who have completed their minimal essential experiences could have the
      option to participate in a selective course that would further their knowledge;
      perhaps consider a schedule for having the selective a few days a week and still be
      able to care for patients on other days.
    - Offer options to students; a selective course in digital dentistry could be beneficial.

• There was concern regarding redundancies, and the discussion helped delineate the difference between redundancies and repeating to learn the material.

<u>ACTION ITEM</u>: Committee members should bring this topic back to their departments to gather input. Discussion will be continued at the next Curriculum Committee meeting.
