II. Request: PERI Nupro Prophy Head – Dr. T. Katsaros, Mr. K. Scandrett
PERIO has requested to buy four units of the Nupro Prophy Head, one for each hygienist and one as a backup along with 20 metal sleeves. Mr. Scandrett discussed how an employee had a repetitive hand injury, causing the employee to be out of work for six weeks which precipitated the process to find an alternative for the hygienist in the PERIO department to have the flexibility and the motion that they need to reduce hand fatigue. The Nupro Prophy is one that has two different modalities. You can use a foot pedal or smart mode technology which allows the hygienist to use pressure sensing to turn on and off. These would not be used by students or faculty, strictly just the 3 hygienists in the PERIO clinic. The Nupro Prophy is from a reputable company, has a great warranty of 3 years and the pricing was not much different than from other companies.
